

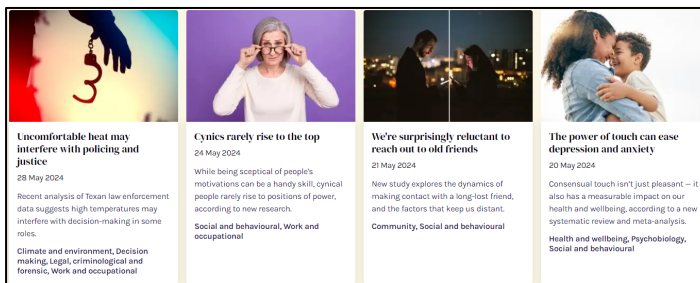


Conyers Sixth Form Transition Work
