Conyers School Arbor Account

You will be sent information as to how you can access your parent Arbor account in due course. Arbor is our cloud based system meaning that parents and staff can work more easily and collaboratively. We can keep you informed about your child's life at school from attendance to trips and payments in a much more accessible way. Once logged into Arbor, we will need to update your child's information and we will provide more information in due course.

Free School Meals

Free school meals are supplied to some students by reason of their parents' income level in accordance with a scale determined by the Government. Every effort is made to ensure that children who receive free school meals cannot be readily identified by other students.
